Provide formal coursework feedback within 3 working weeks of formal assessment deadlines.

Coursework feedback is an extremely important factor in enhancing and maintaining academic excellence at Edinburgh Napier. Being proactive as a student in the feedback process will help you achieve your potential.

Develop your learning



Self-assess and improve your future performance



Develop reflective skills for both self and peer evaluation



Take part in progress reviews and act on the feedback provided to you

Complete course and module questionnaires e.g. the National Student Survey (NSS)
